

Shutting Off Your Customer Water Valve Located Near the WSA Meter Box

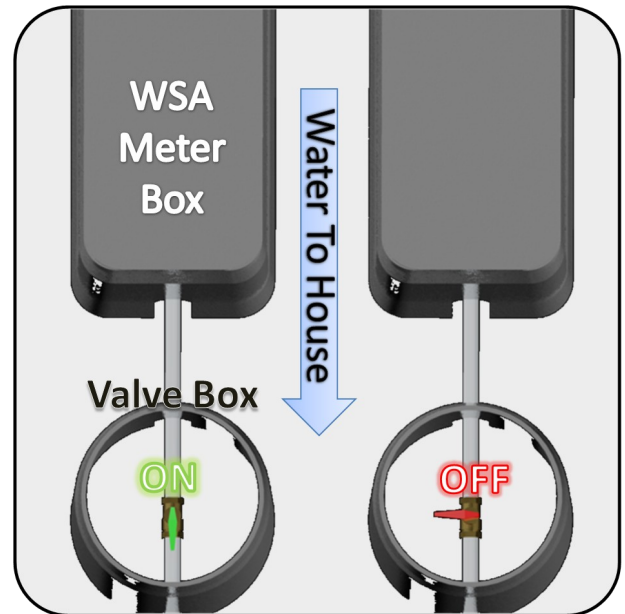
Water valves control the flow of water through the pipes in your home. Most water-related repairs and installations can be made simply by closing the water valve under the sink or attached to an appliance rather than shutting off the main water to your home.

In some cases, however, it's better to shut off the main water valve for your entire home, such as when plumbing renovations are needed, when replacing water valves, when there is a large water leak, or when you're going to be out of town for any extended period of time.

Because WSA's meter box is WSA's property, and customers are not permitted to open the box for any reason, but also recognizing that our customers could benefit from being able to turn off their own water supply when needed ...

A customer valve box is, or will be, installed at no cost to you.

You will then be able to turn off your main water valve without calling WSA and paying for a service-trip charge.



Instructions for Use

- Locate the round black water valve box buried at ground level near your water meter.
- Open the round top.
- Slowly turn the lever a quarter turn clockwise to shut off the main water valve.
- Slowly turn the lever a quarter turn counterclockwise to turn the main water valve back on.
- Replace the top.
