Douglas County continues the Level 2 Drought Response into summer 2017

Due to extremely dry conditions, the Georgia Environmental Protection Division has declared a level 2 drought in nine Metro-Atlanta counties, including Douglas.

Please be aware of the current outdoor watering restrictions which include the following limitations:

- (a) Outdoor watering for gardens, lawns, and trees will be limited to twice a week on an odd-even schedule. Even numbered addresses may water on Wednesday and Saturday between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. Odd numbered addresses may water on Thursday and Sunday between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m.

- (b) The following outdoor water uses are not allowed:

- Washing streets, gutters, sidewalks, or driveways
- Ornamental uses such as fountains or waterfalls
- Charity or non-commercial fund-raiser car washes
- Non-commercial washing or pressure washing
- Washing vehicles (cars, boats, etc.) at home
