

The Douglasville – Douglas County Water and Sewer Authority is seeking applicants for the position of Electrician. The Authority operates the water, sewer, and stormwater systems for Douglas County and the City of Douglasville. The Maintenance Division is made up of five departments and 86 employees with skill levels that include laborers, equipment operators, mechanics, electricians, and tradesmen. The Electrician works in the Plants and Lift Stations Maintenance department under the supervision of the Lead Electrician and Maintenance Superintendent.

This employee is responsible for the electrical maintenance and repair of water/wastewater treatment plants, pump stations, Authority facilities, and all related equipment. An employee in this classification may work independently or as a crew leader with other electricians, mechanics, laborers and the pump station operators during repair assignments. This person assists in developing and implementing preventive maintenance programs and maintains detailed records. This position is on call 24-hour, 7 days a week.

Qualifications include a two year technical degree in electrical maintenance or electronics, and five years experience in electrical maintenance, electrical troubleshooting, and/or motor controls. Must possess a valid State of Georgia driver's license and satisfactory motor vehicle record. Desirable qualifications include a State of Georgia Electrical License, Electrical Safety Training Certificates, and possession of a Class "A" CDL (Commercial Driver's License). Strong electrical troubleshooting experience is desired.

The median salary range for this position is \$52,624.
